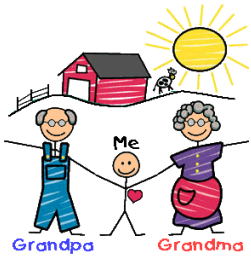

## VISIT BY FABIO THE THERAPY HORSE

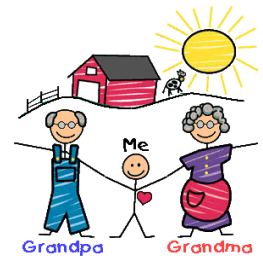
