SENIOR FARMERS’ MARKET CHECKS

Farmers’ Market Checks will be available starting Wednesday, June 1st for Berks County and Montgomery County seniors age 60 and older who meet the income eligibility guidelines. Checks can be picked up at Boyertown Area Multi-Service on the following dates: Wednesday, June 1st and June 8th; Tuesday, June 14th, 21st, and 28th, from 10 a.m. to 12 Noon and from 1 to 2 p.m. After June, any remaining checks will be distributed by appointment until they are gone.

Seniors must be 60 or older by December 31st of this year and meet the income eligibility guidelines of \$21,978 annually for a one person household or \$29,637 for a two person household.

These checks can be redeemed for fresh fruits and vegetables grown or growable in Pennsylvania at any participating farmer’s

market or stand. Each eligible recipient receives 4 - \$5 Farmers’ Market Checks.

Recipients will be asked to provide proof of residency and age when picking up their checks. If a recipient cannot pick up checks for themselves, they can have a proxy do it for them. However, a proxy form must be completed. Proxy forms will be available at the Multi-Service reception desk.
